13. Understand the analytical impact during an ERP modernization or system co-existence scenario.

- Hands-on practice with ABAP Development Tools (ADT) in Eclipse for custom CDS View creation.
- Utilizing CDS annotations for analytical enablement, exposure, and security.
- Creating Custom Analytical Queries using the Query Designer and Query Browser.
- Case Study: Building a real-time 'Open Sales Order' report using a join of multiple Finance/SD CDS Views.

3. S/4HANA Analytical Consumption & Fiori

- Exploring standard SAP Fiori analytical apps like Overview Pages and Analytical List Pages (ALP).
- Using the Manage KPIs and Reports Fiori app to define and track key business metrics.
- Integration with SAP Analytics Cloud for richer data storytelling via live connection.
- Personalizing the Fiori Launchpad for role-based, immediate insight-to-action scenarios.
- Case Study: Implementing a 'Cash Flow Projection' Smart Business KPI with drill-down capabilities for the CFO.

4. Oracle ERP Transactional Business Intelligence (OTBI)

- Deep dive into the OTBI architecture, subject areas, and the underlying data structure.
- Developing complex, multi-subject area analyses using the Oracle BI Composer and Answers.
- Designing interactive and role-specific dashboards with embedded OTBI reports.
- Implementing Oracle's data security and access control model for transactional reports.
- Case Study: Creating a "Procurement Spend Analysis" dashboard that aggregates data across multiple legal entities.

5. Advanced Oracle Fusion Analytics Cloud (OFAC)

- Understanding the purpose and components of the dedicated Fusion Analytics platform.
- Exploring the pre-built content and data models in the Oracle Autonomous Data Warehouse.
- Extending standard OFAC content with custom metrics and business logic.
- Using Oracle Analytics Cloud for advanced predictive and embedded visualizations.
- Case Study: Augmenting the standard OFAC Supply Chain Analytics to track custom warehouse utilization metrics.

6. Cross-Platform Data Integration & Governance

- Strategies for integrating and reconciling data between SAP and Oracle environments for holistic reporting.
- Configuring robust role-based access control in both S/4HANA and Oracle.
- Establishing data governance standards for analytical metadata and definitions.
- Leveraging embedded tools for transparent and auditable reporting for regulatory compliance.
- Case Study: Designing a security model that grants Finance Users access to S/4HANA GL data and Oracle HCM headcount reports.

7. Performance & Extensibility

- Techniques for query optimization, including efficient CDS view coding and index usage.
- Managing hot, warm, and cold data and its impact on analytical performance.
- Extending standard SAP and Oracle analytical content without modification
- Identifying and resolving common performance bottlenecks in analytical queries.

- Case Study: Optimizing a monthly financial reconciliation report that initially took 15 minutes to run down to under 5 seconds.

8. The Future: AI, Machine Learning & Intelligent ERP

- Utilizing the foundation for Predictive Accounting in S/4HANA Finance.
- Connecting analytical views to external or embedded Machine Learning services.
- The impact of Generative AI and large language models on ERP reporting.
- Overview of future developments in SAP Analytics Cloud and Oracle Fusion Analytics.
- Case Study: Simulating the use of SAP's embedded ML to predict overdue invoices based on live transactional data.
